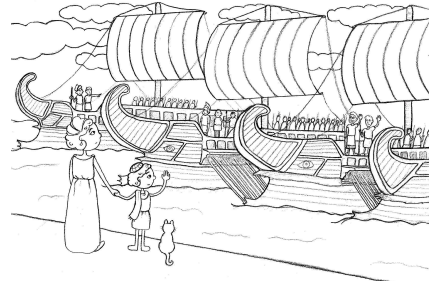


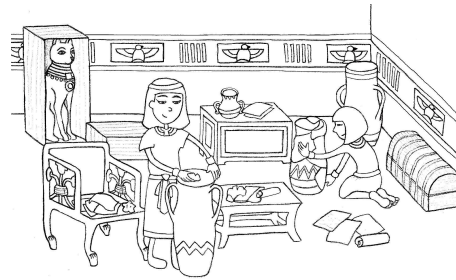
# Sappho: The Poetess

1. Sappho was a Greek poetess from the island of Lesbos who lived with her parents and three brothers. She lived from 630 BC to 580 BC.



2. When a war broke out, her brothers had to fight. Sappho wrote a poem about them.



3. Her fans included Plato, the philosopher; Solon, one of the Seven Sages of Greece; and the ancient Egyptian scholars.



4. However, over time fire, flood, neglect, and the disapproval of others took a devastating toll on her work.



5. Then in 2014, a new poem was discovered. Ancient Egyptians used to pack their things with papyrus and one day a poem was found on the papyrus inside a vase.
